



**ELIGIBILITY GUIDELINES
DYE FAMILY AWARD**

You are eligible for consideration if:

- You were enrolled full time as a high school senior during 2019-2020, graduated in the spring/summer of 2020 and have been accepted into a four-year or two-year college in the United States for the first time no later than the fall following graduation; AND
- You are EITHER enrolled in one or more of The First Tee of South Central Wisconsin's programs OR are serving as a First Tee of South Central Wisconsin chapter mentor or member of the Youth Advisory Board; AND
- You achieved a Birdie or higher level within The First Tee on or before August 1, 2020; AND
- You have a history of community service or "giving back."
- You will need to submit by midnight on August 1, 2020:
 - A completed application form.
 - A personal statement describing how The First Tee has made a difference in your life or the life of your mentee(s). Minimum of 300 words, maximum of 500 words.
 - A personal statement explaining why community service and volunteerism is important to you. Minimum of 300 words, maximum of 500 words.
 - A resume listing accomplishments in community service, academics, activities, arts and athletics, and describing your plans for college.
 - An official high school grades transcript that includes your grade point average.
 - Test results from the ACT (American College Testing) or SAT examination. (These test results are recommended but not mandatory).
 - A letter of recommendation from a high school teacher, counselor or community service supervising adult.
